The events begin with a tour of the Elizabeth Cady Stanton House with tour guides Elizabeth Cady Stanton (portrayed by Dr. Melinda Grube) and Coline Jenkins (great-great-granddaughter of Stanton). The Stanton House is located at 32 Washington Street, Seneca Falls.

At 9:30 am, all are encouraged to participate in the Women's Suffrage Profession from the Stanton House to the Wesleyan Chapel. Participants are encouraged to dress in period attire from 1848 to 1920. The procession is sponsored by Friends of Women's Rights National Historical Park and begins at the Stanton House, 32 Washington Street, Seneca Falls.
